

GUIDELINES FOR CULTURAL ARTS**RATIONALE:**

Hauraki Plains College recognises the rich diversity of talents and abilities in individuals and the importance of cultural, artistic and creative endeavour pertaining to a broad education and the holistic wellbeing of students (NEG 5).

PURPOSES:

1. To encourage students to participate in, enjoy and achieve in cultural and arts activities.
2. To encourage appreciation for the cultural arts

GUIDELINES:

- 1.1 An Annual Plan for Cultural Arts will be developed and implemented by the Arts Co-ordinator.
 - 1.2 Cultural and artistic talents of individual students will be identified and where possible students will be provided with opportunities to develop and express these talents.
 - 1.3 Students will be consulted regarding the cultural and related arts programme.
 - 1.4 The Arts co-ordinator will assist staff in providing cultural activities and opportunities for students.

- 2.1 A range of activities and opportunities will be provided in the belief that all students need to be exposed to a variety of cultural, artistic, recreational and creative fields.
 - 2.2 Parents and community will be informed and encouraged to support school cultural events.
