

## GUIDELINES FOR SPORTS

### **RATIONALE:**

Hauraki Plains College recognises the rich diversity of talents and abilities in individuals and the importance of providing opportunities for students to participate in, enjoy and achieve in a wide range of sporting and recreational activities (NEG 5)

### **PURPOSES:**

1. To encourage students to participate in and enjoy a range of sporting and recreational activities.
2. To promote and recognise achievement and excellence in sport.

### **GUIDELINES:**

- 1.1 A strategic and annual plan for sports and recreation will be developed.
- 1.2 The Sports Co-ordinator will co-ordinate and promote the SPORT FIT programme and work with and support Student Sports Leaders, Hapu leaders and teachers to provide sporting opportunities for students.
- 1.3 The Sports Co-ordinator will assist in communication between school, students and parents.
- 1.3 Sporting events will take consideration of the need to preserve classroom teaching time.
- 2.1 A Sports Handbook will be developed and maintained to ensure effective management and consistent expectations of all Sporting activities.
- 2.2 The Sports Committee will be established to co-ordinate school events, decide major sporting awards, promote Fair Play and recommend the allocation of funds and resources. This committee will consist of representatives from Senior Management, Sports Co-ordinator, HOD PE, Student Sports Leaders and Sport Waikato.
